Driving Policy for Red Lodge Music Festival

1. No motorized transportation is allowed to be used by students at camp!

a. This includes scooters, one wheelers, etc.

2. Students that are driving themselves to camp

- a. Must let registration staff know that they drove to camp.
- b. Must check in with Counselor at their assigned lodging site.
- c. Will be asked to park in a specific area of parking lot.
- d. Must turn keys into Counseling staff after they have checked into their room and unloaded their vehicle.
- e. Keys will be returned to them upon check out time on last day of camp.

3. Off Campus Students Driving to Camp

- a. Must let registration staff know at time of check in.
- b. Will Park at Civic Center Parking Lot at the start of each day.
 - i. They are not permitted to drive between classes or mealtimes.
 - ii. They must attend all assigned rehearsals / classes / concerts.
 - iii. They cannot transport anyone but themselves.
- c. Will check out with Counselor / Staff after concert each night before driving home.

4. Parents driving off campus student(s)

- a. Must let registration staff know at time of check in.
- b. Can drop off at 1st rehearsal location for the day.
 - i. Students are expected to be part of camp for the day.
 - ii. Parents can only transport their own children.
- c. Students will be checked out by counselor / staff and dismissed to parents picking them up after the concert / event each evening.
