AUDITIONS:

Saturday, June 14 from 2:00-4:00 pm, following registration. Audition materials are posted at www.rlmf.org in the spring of 2025. Students are to prepare these materials, plus a 1-2 minute piece of solo literature. Solos need not be memorized. Sight reading is also part of auditioning. Orchestra and wind ensemble seating will be announced on Sunday at rehearsal and is strategically designed to provide

strength in each section.

HONOR JAZZ COMBO AUDITION PROCESS

If interested, senior-level students will audition on Saturday after auditioning on their main instrument. Rehearsals will take place during senior small wind ensemble time (11:00 am Sun-F). Therefore, students will need to choose if they wish to play in a small chamber ensemble (brass quintet, for example), or the jazz combo. Chosen students are expected to play in Jazz I as well. CLOTHING: Casual clothing may be worn to classes and rehearsals.

PRIVATE LESSONS: May be arranged by the student with individual instructors upon arrival at Festival.

Fees are \$30.00 per half hour, payable in cash to the instructor.

TRANSPORTATION: Students arriving in Billings by bus or airlines, may arrange for transportation to Red Lodge.

Students are not allowed, at any time, to ride in vehicles other than with camp staff or their own parents/guardians. Parents/guardians may designate, in writing before the camp's opening day,

another person to transport the student to or from camp.

STUDENT ILLNESS:

If the student is ill, he/she will contact a counselor immediately. Medical expenses due to illness or accident are the student's responsibility. If the student is too ill to attend a recital, he/she will remain in their room and will not be allowed to leave for other activities that evening.

DISCIPLINE:

All discipline problems will be addressed immediately by the counseling staff and/or Festival Director. If a student is sent home, or leaves the camp early, no refund of fees will be made.

REMINDERS:

- Students must attend all scheduled classes and concerts and remain in attendance for the entire concert.
- No boys in any girls' rooms ever vice versa.
- No riding in unauthorized vehicles except for own parents or staff vehicles.
- No driving of a motor vehicle while at the Festival.
- Students may use bicycles for transportation while attending camp.
- No smoking or use of tobacco at any time, regardless of age.
- No alcoholic beverages or drugs at any time. (Montana law).
- Common sense room care at all times. Careless damage will be equally assessed to room occupants.
- Any accidental damage should be reported promptly to your counselor.
- Discipline problems will be addressed immediately by counselors and/or the Festival Director.
- Dress at concerts is a matter of respect. No jeans, shorts, or t-shirts, please.
- Students receiving financial aid will be at all assigned duties on time.
- Civic Center balcony is closed for evening concerts.
