

STUDENT CONDUCT POLICY

* It is the Red Lodge Music Festival's intent that students have a safe, educational, and appropriate experience at the Festival. Only exemplary conduct will be accepted from students at Red Lodge Music Festival. Students must be on their best behavior at all times- in public, in motels, and at all performances.

* Daily Schedules will be posted conspicuously. Students must attend all scheduled classes and concerts. If you are too ill to attend, please contact your counselor immediately. Students who are ill will not be allowed to leave their room for other activities that evening.

* Be on time.

* Facilities are to be treated with care. Any accidental damage should be reported to your counselor promptly. Careless damage to motel rooms will be equally assessed to room occupants.

* Special care should be used to see that all personal and school property is properly cared for. Place ID on all personal and school items.

* Students are not allowed to ride in vehicles other than with camp staff or their own parents/guardians and are not allowed to drive a motor vehicle while at the Festival. Students who drive themselves to the Festival will need to turn in their car keys to the counselors upon arrival.

* Parents/guardians wishing to have their child released early from camp before the final Sunday performance should fill out an early release form and return it before the beginning of the Festival.

* The Red Lodge Music Festival has a ZERO TOLERANCE policy regarding alcohol, drugs, tobacco, marijuana, e-cigarettes, weapons, or disruptive behavior, including bullying, and harassment regardless of age. "Disruptive behavior," "Bullying," and "Harassment" include but are not limited to actual or threatened physical assault, misuse of digital media and communications, possession or dissemination of pornography, and unwelcome sexual advances. RLMF strictly PROHIBITS smoking, possession or use of illegal drugs, tobacco, marijuana, e-cigarettes, alcohol, or weapons while attending the Red Lodge Music Festival.

* Harassment, bullying, or any behavior that is disruptive or infringes in any way on the safety and welfare of other campers or staff will be grounds for dismissal of the camper, in the exclusive discretion of the Camp Director and/or Assistant Camp Director. Campers unable to abide by the rules are subject to dismissal with NO REFUND.

* In order to ensure safety and discipline, the Festival retains the authority to conduct routine inspections of motel rooms and the exterior of vehicles. The Festival may also conduct reasonable searches of students, their belongings, and the interior of vehicles when there is reasonable suspicion to believe that students may be in possession of contraband. Such inspections may be conducted without notice, without student consent, and without a search warrant. Police may be called to the Festival at the request of the Festival staff. Any contact between the Festival and the Red Lodge police department will generally be made through the Festival Director.

* Students are to stay in their rooms after curfew/bed check with doors fully locked until daybreak. Do not open your door for anyone except a counselor during this time. Red Lodge Music Festival curfew times are in accordance with the city of Red Lodge statutes and are enforced nightly by the Red Lodge Police Department. No boys in any girls' rooms; no girls in any boys' rooms, ever.

* Discipline problems, if any, will be dealt with immediately and appropriately by the counselors and/or the Festival Director or Assistant Director.
